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BACP competence frameworks

Set out the evidence-based knowledge, skills and abilities required for counsellors and psychotherapists to work safely and effectively


- with particular client groups, and/or
- within specific contexts, and/or
- with specific presenting issues

Generally targeted for post-qualification practitioners (exception: Counselling Skills)

Generally model-neutral (exception: Counselling for Depression)

Generally for dyadic practice

BACP competence frameworks & SCoPEd



BACP competence frameworks assume SCoPEd column A competences have been achieved via generic core training, and build from there.

They not repeat SCoPEd content.



Intended for use by practitioners, supervisors, trainers, employers, service providers, researchers to promote evidence-based good practice, learning and development




