

Counsellors Needed for Qualitative Research

Who can take part?

You may be eligible if you are:

- A qualified psychotherapist or counsellor with BACP or UKCP registration
- Currently in clinical practice with adult clients
- A parent or carer of at least one diagnosed neurodivergent child aged 5–18

What does participation involve?

- One semi-structured interview (approximately 60–90 minutes)
- Conducted online via Microsoft Teams and audio-recorded
