

## Register Advisory Board (RAB) Meeting

18<sup>th</sup> April 2018

### Summary of Minutes

- The Board were advised that new BACP website was now operational and open to the public.
- The Board were updated that the number of Registrants was now 34,998.
- The Register Officer (Entry) attended the meeting and advised the Certificate of Proficiency had now moved away from hosted events and moved to an online based assessment system.
- The Board were updated that the Scope of Practice and Education (SCoPEd) project was a direct result of a collaboration with BACP, BPC and UKCP. The Group meets monthly to look at evidence to map the landscape to see if there is differentiation in the current titles, levels of training and practice requirements. The Board were informed that the initial mapping has finished and an Expert Reference Group (ERG) has been recruited to look at mapping and assessing what needs to be done to complete the work.
- The Board were informed that new governance structures were being put in place with six new committees overseeing the activities of the Association. The Register Advisory Board was to be disbanded with a new Public Protection Committee set up to take delegated responsibility for the public protection strategy. Those members who wished to move to the new Committee were asked to make it known to the Governance Manager who would give details on how to apply.
