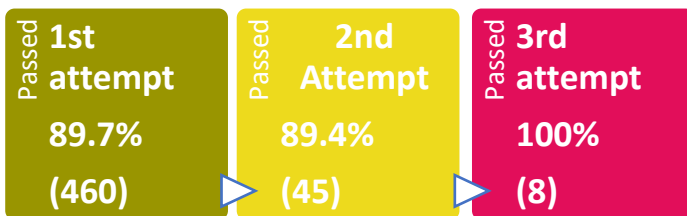


Annual audit report 2017-2018

Audit selection

602 members were randomly selected between April 2017 and March 2018. Selected members were asked to submit their record from the previous year including their continuing professional development (CPD) record, supervision record, contact details of their supervisor and proof of indemnity insurance cover.



The remaining auditees either lapsed or cancelled their membership (52), deferred for 12 months (27) or were removed from the register (5).

CPD analysis

Members maintained and developed their continuing professional development through means such as **attending workshops and conferences, reading therapy today, and carrying out self-care activities**. Some of the common areas of development included **working with young people, learning new theory, and working with differences**.

Members gave examples of CPD they recorded over the time being audited, varying in numbers between two and sixteen.

Some of the examples of CPD themes given were found to be significantly related to activities. For example, **attending lectures and reading** proved to be significantly related to many CPD themes.

Supervision analysis

Members used a variety of formats and modes of delivery to meet the requirement for supervision.

Members who only had individual supervision:

61.3%

Members who only had group supervision:

1.3%

Members who had individual and group supervision:

21.9%

Members that were selected for audit had over 90 minutes of supervision per month:

76.4%

This included accredited and non-accredited members.

Removal of registration

Five members were removed from the register between April 2017 and March 2018.

The reasons they were removed may have been that they'd retired, hadn't met the CPD requirement, didn't have adequate indemnity insurance cover, or didn't submit information for audit when asked.

52 members had either lapsed or cancelled their membership after being selected for audit.

8.8%

41 members had been selected more than once since the first audit in 2013.

Assessor's feedback

The register team commented on the **extremely high quality of the audit submissions** and the **commitment to CPD and supervision demonstrated by members throughout**.
