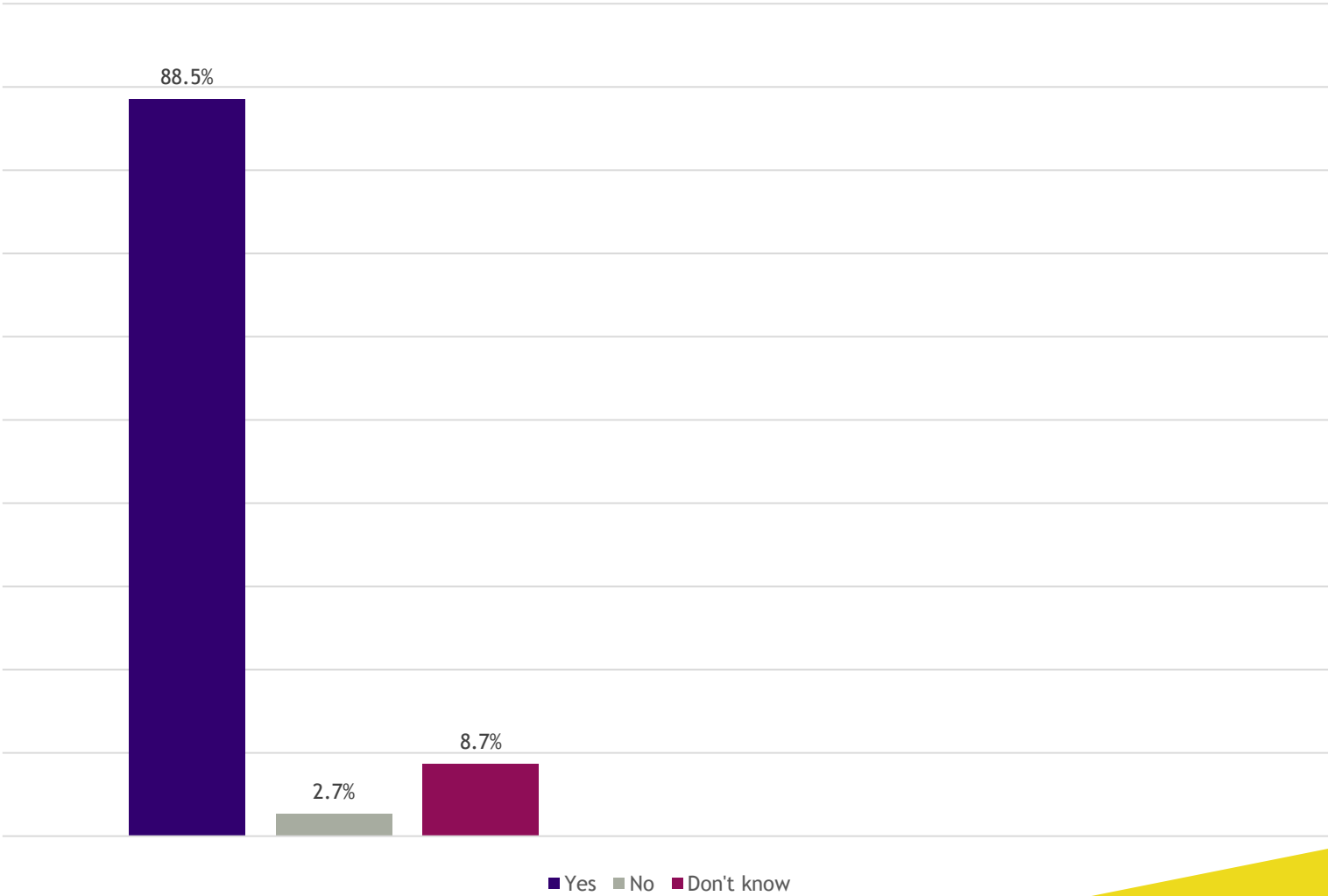

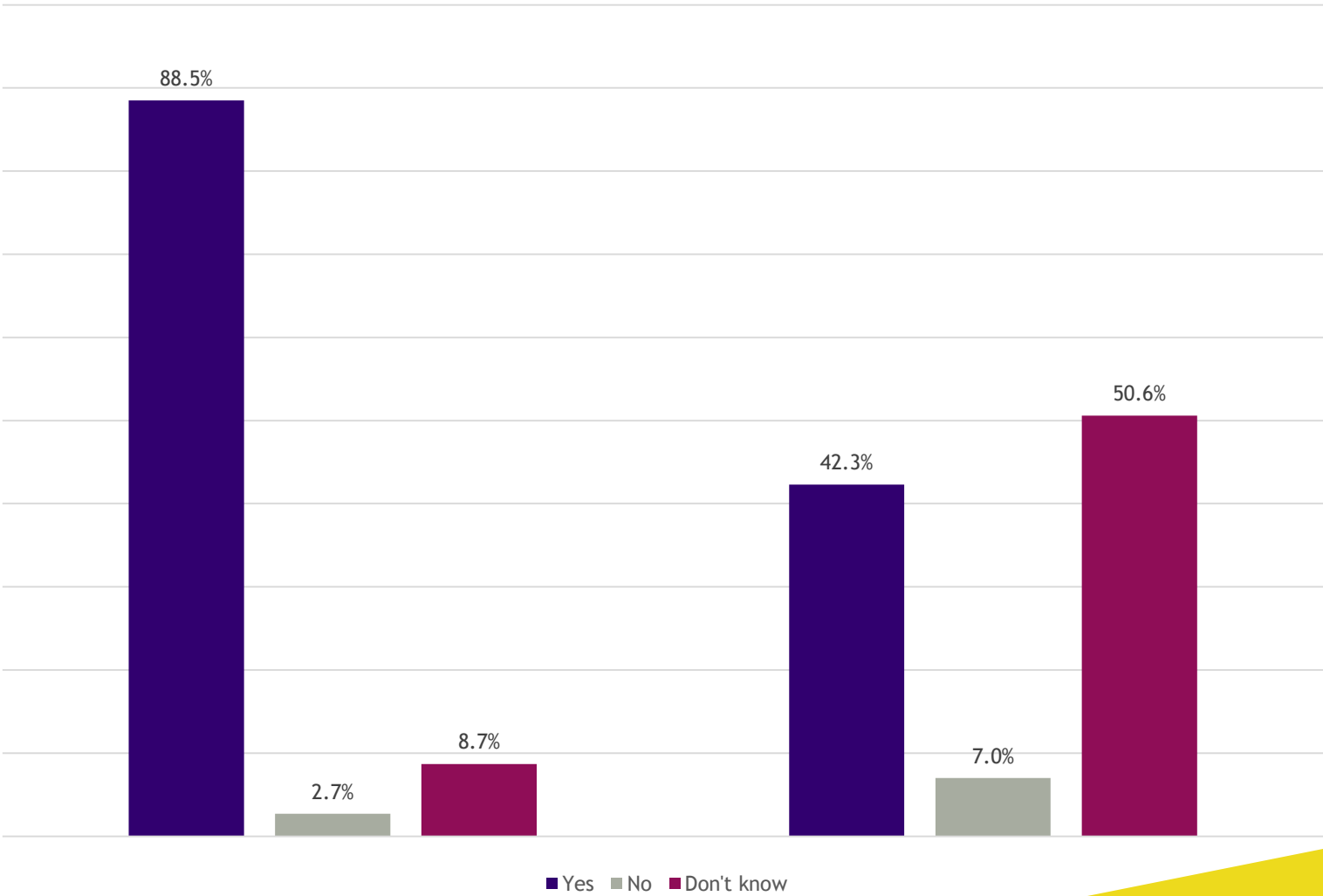

- **Children, Young People & Families:** School based counselling trial (ETHOS); Relate data analysis; PhD studentship; SCORE; RTCC
- **Older People:** Counselling in care homes; Barriers and access to counselling, clinical supervision for allied health professionals, Coaching for retirement planning; PhD studentship
- **Humanistic therapies:** Trial comparing CBT and counselling within IAPT (PRaCTICED); IAPT data analysis; SCORE project; Research clinic consortium project; PhD studentships

- **Research dissemination:** *Counselling and Psychotherapy Research (CPR)*; Gold Open Access; Research conference & webcast; attendance and presenting at other conferences
